Johnson which addresses the issue of preferential absorption of the piperonyl butoxide into the fabric; (2) the CAS Number and the percentage composition of the polypropylene fabric, and a statement regarding the manufacturing process; (3) an abreviated definition of "Meltblown"; (4) a photomicrograph of the meltblown web; and (5) an Material Safety Data Sheet for the "PRO-FAX" Polypropylene Homopolymer Pellets.

We believe this is a correct interpretation of the definition of a pesticide "...a mixture of substances intended...to control or mitigate a pest". We are therefore registering this pesticide based upon the formula II, which includes the towelette, only. We suggest that you contact your Product Manager regarding revision of the CSF for registration 62562-1.
- d. The CSF (Confidential Statement of Formula II) for this product indicates that the nominal concentration for the active ingredients pyrethrins and piperonyl butoxide, respectively, are 0.080% and 0.799%. Correct the label declaration for the active ingredients statement.
- e. The heading INERT INGREDIENTS should appear In the label ingredient statement in the same type size and aligned to the same margin as the heading ACTIVE INGREDIENTS.
- 3. Submit one (1) copy of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment. Refer to the A-79 enclosure for a further description of final printed labeling.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA section 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.
