## DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

### ON ANIMALS:

To protect animals from horn flies, house flies, mosquitoes and gnats: Apply a light mist sufficient to wet the tips of the hair. To control stable flies, horse flies, deer flies, apply 2 ounces per adult animal, sufficient to wet the hair, but not to soak the hide. Repeat treatment once or twice daily or at intervals necessary to give continued protection.

To control blood-sucking lice: Apply the spray lightly to infested areas, using a stiff brush to get the spray to the base of the hair. Use 2 ounces or less per animal. Repeat every two or three weeks as required.

### BARN, MILK ROOMS, DAIRY PLANTS:

To control flies, mosquitoes, and gnats: Apply as a fog or fine mist, directing the spray toward the ceiling and upper corners of the room until the area is filled with mist, using about 2 ounces per 1000 cubic feet of space. For best results, close windows and doors before spraying and keep closed for 10 to 15 minutes. Vacate the area and ventilate before re-occupying. Repeat application as necessary.

## STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

### PESTICIDE STORAGE AND SPILL PROCEDURE:

Store upright at room temperature. Avoid exposure to extreme temperatures. In case of spill or leakage, soak up with an absorbant material such as sand, sawdust, earth, fuller's earth, etc. Dispose of with chemical waste.

**PESTICIDE DISPOSAL:** Pesticide, spray mixture or rinse water that cannot be used according to label instructions must be disposed of at or by an approved waste disposal facility.

**CONTAINER DISPOSAL:** Triple rinse (or equivalent) then offer for recycling or reconditioning, or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill or by other approved State and Local procedures.
