DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

CAP THREADING INSTRUCTIONS: Remove entire cap from container. Locate the first wipe in the center of roll. Thread wipe through center of cap. Place cap firmly back onto container. Pull wipe up to release.

ANIMALS: To protect animals from house flies, house flies, mosquitoes, fleas, ticks, mites, deer ticks and gnats: First brush animal to remove excess dirt and dust. Apply a light coating sufficient to wet the tips of the hair. To control stable flies, horse flies and deer flies: Apply sufficient to wet the hair, but not to soak the hide. Recommended for use on face and around eyes and ears. Repeat as necessary to give continued protection.

To control lice: Apply wipe lightly to infested areas. Repeat every two or three weeks as required. Wash hands thoroughly after application.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

Storage: Store in a cool dry place away from heat or open flame.

Disposal: Do not reuse container. Wrap and put in trash. Wrap towelette in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash.
