Subject: Amended label for SPI Personal Insect Repellent
Towelette, EPA Reg. No. 11715-242.

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable subject to the comments listed below. Five copies of the finished labeling must be submitted prior to releasing the product for shipment.

Modify the Statement of Practical Treatment to read as follows:

If swallowed: Call a physician or Poison Control Center. Drink 1 or 2 glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching back of throat with finger. If person is unconscious, do not give anything by mouth and do not induce vomiting.

If in eyes: Flush with plenty of water. Get medical attention if irritation persists.

Modify the second sentence of the Directions for use to read as follows:

Read all directions before using this product.

Add the following statement to the directions for use:

"If you go to a doctor, take this repellent with you."

Modify the Container Disposal statement to read as follows:

Container Disposal: Securely wrap original container in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash.

The Net Contents statement must include U.S. units of measurement.

CAUTION: For external use only. May cause eye irritation. Do not get in eyes or mouth. Harmful if swallowed. Avoid contact with lips, open cuts or irritated skin. Do not expose treated skin to sparks or flame until liquid has evaporated.

PHYSICAL / CHEMICAL HAZARD

FLAMMABLE. Keep away from heat or open flame.

Do not use on Rayon, Spandex, or Dynel. May be used on Wool, or Cotton.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TIPS

If swallowed: Call a physician or Poison Control Center.
If in eyes: Flush with plenty of water. Get medical attention.
If on skin: May cause skin reactions in rare cases. If severe, wash with soap and water. Get medical attention if irritation persists.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. Read all directions (for use) before using.

Cap Threading Instructions: Remove entire cap from pouch; discard in appropriate place. Locate the first wipe thread; thread through center of cap. Place cap firmly back on pouch; wipe up to release.

Foil Pouch Instructions (multiple towelette pack): Remove towelette from pouch, exposing resealable inner pouch. Pull pouch apart to expose towelette. Remove towelette from inner pouch immediately to preserve product quality.

Foil Pouch Instructions (individual towelette pack): Remove towelette and dispose of pouch in trash.

Unfold towelette and wipe evenly over exposed skin. To remove chiggers from clothing, apply liberally along all open seams, the fly and the cuffs of trousers, tops of socks, eyelets, and clothing that may contact the ground, weeds, or other insects. Use repellent to cover exposed skin and/or clothing. Do not apply to wounds, or irritated skin. Do not apply to eyes and mouth. Do not use on the hands of young children. Do not use under clothing. Frequent reapplication and saturation is unnecessary. When returning indoors, wash treated skin with soap and water. Use of this product may cause skin reactions.

Call a physician or Poison Control Center. If swallowed, drink glasses of water and induce vomiting with fingers. If person is not giving anything by mouth and is vomiting.
