

STATEMENT OF PRACTICE

If swallowed: Call a physician or Poison Control Center.
If on skin: Remove contaminated clothing and wash with soap and water.
If in eyes: Flush with plenty of water. Get medical attention.

PHYSICAL OR CHEMICAL PROPERTIES

Flammable. Contents under pressure. Keep away from heat and flame. Do not puncture or incinerate container. 130°F may cause bursting.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with labeling.

Hold container 4-6 inches from animal and direct spray into fur so that skin is treated and all insects are reached, including legs and feet. Spray animal until thoroughly wet. Do not spray around eyes, on face or on genital area, or in ventilated areas. Do not use more often than once per week. If bedding is heavily flea infested, remove old bedding and replace with new. New bedding may be used to treat bedding.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Storage: Store in a cool dry area away from heat and flame.
Disposal: Securely wrap container in plastic and discard in trash. Do not incinerate.
