Rub spray down into fur so that skin is treated and all insects are directly contacted. Be sure to include legs and feet. Spray animal until thoroughly wet but avoid run off. Do not spray around eyes, on face or on genital area to avoid irritation. Use spray in well ventilated areas. Do not use more often than once every two days on animal. If pet bedding is heavily flea infested, remove old bedding and replace with fresh; spray may be used to treat bedding.

**STORAGE AND DISPOSAL**

**STORAGE:** Store in a cool dry area away from heat and open flame.

**DISPOSAL:** Securely wrap container in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash. Do not incinerate or puncture.
