The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable subject to the comments below. Two (2) copies of the finished labeling must be submitted prior to releasing the product for shipment. A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records.

1. Move the following statement which is currently located in the Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals section to the Directions for Use:

“Remove pets and birds and cover fish aquaria before spraying.”

2. The oral (If Swallowed) and ocular (If In Eyes) First Aid statements are not required based on the product's acute toxicity profile and may be deleted. However, EPA has no objections if you wish to retain these statements.

### PHYSICAL OR CHEMICAL HAZARDS

Contents under pressure. Do not use or store near heat or open flame. Do not puncture or incinerate container. Exposure to temperatures above 130°F. may cause bursting. Do not apply this product in conduits, motor housing, junctions and switch boxes or other electrical equipment because of

possible shock hazard. Do not use on surfaces than can be harmed or stained by water.

#### **ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS**

This product is toxic to fish. Do not apply directly to water.

#### **DIRECTIONS FOR USE**

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

In the home, all food processing surfaces and utensils should be covered during treatment or thoroughly washed before use. Exposed food should be covered or removed.

#### **SHAKE WELL BEFORE USING**

Remove protective cap, hold container upright and spray a distance of 12 to 15 inches.

#### **INDOORS**

**Houseflies, Fruit Flies, Mosquitoes, Gnats, Wasps, Hornets, Bees, Black Flies, Skipper Flies, Blow Flies and Small Flying Moths:** Close all doors and windows and direct spray upward into center of room with a slow sweeping motion. Spray 5-10 seconds for average room. Direct spray to all parts of the room, especially windows and other light sources which attract these insects. Keep nozzle in constant motion. Keep room closed for 15 minutes after spraying. Vacate room after treatment and ventilate before reoccupying. Sweep up and discard fallen insects. Repeat treatment as necessary.

#### **OUTDOORS**

Point spray nozzle away from face. Hold can on slight downward angle. For best results, spray when air is calm. Allow a few minutes for product to take effect. Spray with wind if breeze is blowing.

**CRAWLING INSECTS: Ants, Cockroaches, including Asian Cockroaches, Crickets, Centipedes, and Silverfish.** Spray infested surface of patio or picnic area, hitting as many insects as possible. Also spray legs of tables and chairs to repel ants. Spray ant hills for best control.

**FLYING INSECTS: Flies, Mosquitoes, Gnats, Small Flying Moths, Hornets and Yellow Jackets.** Allow fog to drift over area. Direct spray toward bushes, or grass from at least 4 to 6 feet away. Give special attention to breeding areas such as garbage cans and composts piles. Repeat as necessary.

#### **STORAGE AND DISPOSAL**

**STORAGE:** Store in a cool, dry area. Do not use or store below 32°F.

**DISPOSAL:** Do Not Puncture or Incinerate!

**If empty:** Place in trash or offer for recycling if available. **If partly filled:** Call your local solid waste agency or 1-800-CLEANUP for disposal instructions.
