STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

If Inhaled: Remove victim to fresh air. Apply artificial respiration if indicated. **If on Skin:** Wash with plenty of soap and water. Get medical attention. **If in Eyes:** Flush eyes with plenty of water. Call a physician if irritation persists.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS HAZARDS TO HUMANS & DOMESTIC ANIMALS

CAUTION: Harmful if absorbed through the skin. Causes moderate eye irritation. Avoid contact with skin, eyes, or clothing. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling. Avoid contamination of feed and foodstuffs. Remove pets, birds, and cover fish aquariums before spraying.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

This product is toxic to fish, birds and other wildlife. Do not apply directly to water, or to areas where surface water is present or to intertidal areas below the mean high water mark. Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastes.

PHYSICAL OR CHEMICAL HAZARDS

Contents under pressure. Do not use or store near heat or open flame. Do not puncture or incinerate container. Exposure to temperatures above 130°F may cause bursting.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

When using this product as a space spray in food processing plants, food must be removed or covered during treatment. All food processing surfaces must be thoroughly cleaned with an appropriate cleaning agent and rinsed with potable water before reuse.

Do not apply directly to food. Do not apply as a space spray while food processing is underway. In commercial food handling facilities, cover or remove any food during treatment. All food processing surfaces should be

thoroughly cleaned with an effective cleaning compound followed by a potable water rinse before using.

In hospitals, patients should be removed from room prior to treatment. Room should be ventilated for two hours after spraying. Do not return patients to room until after ventilation.

HOME, FOOD PROCESSING AREAS OR GREENHOUSE USE:

For flies, mosquitoes, small flying moths and gnats: Close all doors and windows. Point nozzle upward and away from eyes and face, direct the spray mist to all parts of the room, especially windows and light sources which attract these insects. Fill the room with mist, then leave the treated area. Keep the treated area closed for at least 15 minutes. Thoroughly ventilate the treated area prior to re-entry.

For ants, roaches, waterbugs, sowbugs, spiders, centipedes and other crawling insects: Spray thoroughly into hiding places such as cracks, crevices, moist areas, meter boxes, manholes, opening around pipes and sinks, under refrigerators, baseboards and storage areas. Spray directly on insects whenever possible. Repeat as necessary. **For fleas, ticks and lice:** Spray pet bedding and pet resting areas. Lightly mist spray over carpets or drapery. Do not saturate.

PET USE: Lightly spray pet from head to tail. Avoid getting spray on pet's face, eyes or genitalia. Do not use this product on puppies or kittens under 6 weeks of age.

DAIRY FARM, MILK ROOMS, BEEF CATTLE OPERATIONS, POULTRY HOUSES, HORSE

BARNs OR STABLE USE: Close all doors and windows. Direct spray upwards, spraying 2 to 3 seconds for every 1000 cu. ft. of space, then leave the treated area. Keep the treated area closed for at least 15 minutes. Thoroughly ventilate treated area prior to re-entry. Cover milking utensils and milk to prevent contamination from spray.

ON DAIRY OR BEEF CATTLE, HORSES, PONIES, HOGS OR GOATS: Spray for 5 seconds over back of animal from approximately 2 foot distance. Spot spray

legs and sides of animal. Do not spray directly towards animal's face, eyes or genitalia. Repeat as necessary. This product is authorized by USDA for use in Federally-inspected meat and poultry plants.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal. **Storage:** Store in a cool dry area away from heat or open flame. **Disposal:** Do not reuse empty container. Wrap container and put in trash collection.
