Dear Mr. Washburn:

The revised labeling referenced to above, submitted in connection with the registration under the Federal Insecticide, fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA) as amended, is accepted with the following comments:

- 1) Revise the Precautionary Statements and add "Avoid breathing dust. Wash hands thoroughly with soap and water after handling remove clothing and wash clothing before reuse. Do not contaminate water, food or feed with this product"
- 2) The 30 days prohibition of treating pets with cholinesterase inhibiting pesticides is in contradiction with the "repeat every week if needed"-Revise the re-treatment directions to "Do not reapply this product within 30 days".
- 3) The Note to Physician should be updated to read "Carbaryl is an N-methyl carbamate insecticide which is a cholinesterase inhibitor. Specific antidote consists of atropine. Narcotics and other sedatives should not be used. Drugs like 2-PAM (pyridine-2-aldoxime methiodide) are NOT recommended.
- 4) Add to the Directions for use "This product must not be applied by children or when children are present".

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN AND VETERINARIAN

Carbaryl is a cholinesterase inhibitor. Atropine by injection is antidotal.

USER SAFETY REQUIREMENTS

- Wear long-sleeved shirt, long pants, shoes plus socks and household latex or rubber gloves when applying this product.
- Change clothing as soon as possible after use.
- Wash the outside of gloves before removing. As with any pesticide product, wash hands thoroughly immediately after handling and before eating, smoking or using the toilet.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

This product is extremely toxic to aquatic organisms. Do not apply directly to any body of water. Do not contaminate when disposing of equipment washwaters.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

To control Fleas, Ticks and Lice on Dogs and Cats:

Use product only outside or in a well-ventilated area. Wearing household latex or rubber gloves, dust entire animal, avoiding pet's eyes, nose, mouth and genital areas. Rub or brush pet's hair to work dust down to the skin. Rub dust into hair and around feet, pads and between the toes so that they are well treated. This product should not be applied by children. Do not use on pregnant dogs or cats. Do not use on kittens or puppies under 12 weeks of age. Consult a Veterinarian before using this product on debilitated, aged or

medicated animals. Do not reapply product more than once per week.

Dust bedding, kennel and sleeping area regularly. Dust bedding and doghouse using a shaker can or other dust applicator. Do not use more than once per week.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Store in a cool dry location. Keep cap closed tightly.

DISPOSAL: If empty: Do not reuse this container. Place in trash or offer for recycling if available.

If partly filled: Call your local solid waste or 1-800-CLEANUP for disposal instructions. Never place unused product down any indoor or outdoor drain.
