Amendment - Revised First Aid and Disposal Statements

Speer Py-Perm Total Release Fogger EPA Registration No. 11715-262 Your Submission Dated April 22, 2003

Dear Mr. Washburn:

The amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under section 3 (c)(5) of the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, is acceptable, subject to the comments listed below.

- 1. Under the "Precautionary Statements" section, move the statements "Remove pets, birds...before spraying" to the "Directions for Use" section of your label.
- 2. Either delete the phrase "or when necessary" from the statement "Repeat spraying in two weeks or when necessary" or indicate a time period for retreatment based upon the residual efficacy of your product.
- 3. Delete the phrase "No Unpleasant Odor." This is a subjective statement based on the sensitivity of the user.
- 4. Add the following statement to the "Directions for Use" section of the label: "Do not allow children or pets to contact treated area until surfaces are dry."
- 5. Under Directors for Use add the qualifying phrase "In the home . . . " to the beginning of the statement," All food processing surfaces and utensils . . . etc."
- 6. Replace "USDA" with "federally inspected" i.e., "Not for use in Federally inspected meat and poultry plants."

7. Due to the large amount of solvent in this product add "Contains petroleum distillates" beneath the ingredient statement and under Note to Physician in the First Aid section. Also add the following first aid statement: "If swallowed: immediately call a poison control center or doctor. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control center or doctor. Do not give any liquid to the person. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person."

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

DO NOT use more than one fogger per room. DO NOT use in small, enclosed spaces such as closets, cabinets or under counters or tables. Do not use in a room 5 ft.

5 ft. or smaller; instead, allow fog to enter from other rooms. Turn off ALL ignition sources such as pilot lights (shut off gas valves), other open flames or running electrical applicances that cycle off and on (i.e., refrigerators, thermostats, etc.). Call your gas utility or management company if you need assistance with your pilot lights.

For use in apartments, atties, basements, boats, cabins, campers, closed barns, day camps, garages, homes, horse stables, household storage areas, kennels, pet sleeping areas, rooms, greenhouses (non commercial), ship cabins, bathhouses, seedhouses, washrooms, and the non-food/feed areas of schools, theaters, trucks, warehouses, box cars, hospitals, hotels, industrial plants, motels, and preschools.

Do not use in food/feed areas of food/feed handling establishments, restaurants or other areas where food/feed is commercially prepared or processed. Do not use in serving areas while food is exposed or facility is in operation. HOW TO USE:

Step 1: PREPARATION

Open cupboards, cabinets, trunks, and doors to area to be treated to allow maximum kill in all areas where insects can hide and breed. Close outside doors and windows and shut off fans and air conditioning to maximize killing power of fog. Remove pets, birds, and tightly cover or remove fish bowls and aquariums before spraying. Cover waxed wood floors and waxed furniture in the immediate area surrounding the fogger (Newspapers may be used). Remove or cover exposed foods, dishes, utensils or food handling equipment. All food processing surfaces should be covered during treatment or thoroughly cleaned before using. Shut off electrical appliances. Do not place activated fogger in a cabinet or under a counter or table.

STEP 2: ACTIVATION OF FOGGER SHAKE WELL JUST BEFORE USING.

Place a section of newspaper on floor in center of room to be treated. NOTE: Do not place fogger on waterstainable surface. Tilt can opening away from face and depress tab firmly with thumb until it clicks in locked position. Aiming spray away from face, set fogger on newspaper, leave room and close door. After activation, leave room or house at once. Keep area closed for 2 hours (30 minutes for flying insects) before airing out. Open all doors and windows and allow to air for 30 minutes. Repeat spraying in two weeks or when necessary.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Store in a cool, dry area inaccessible to children and pets and away from heat, sparks or open flame.

DISPOSAL: Do Not Puncture or Incinerate!

If empty: Place in trash or offer for recycling if available. If partly filled; Call your local solid waste agency or 1-800-CLEANUP for disposal instructions.
