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STEP 2: ACTIVATION OF FOGGER
SHAKE WELL JUST BEFORE USING.

Place a section of newspaper on floor in center of room to be treated. NOTE: Do not place fogger on water-stainable surface. Do not place can within 6 feet of pilot lights. Tilt can opening away from face and depress tab firmly with thumb until it clicks in locked position.

Aiming spray away from face, set fogger on newspaper, leave room and close door. After activation, leave room or house at once. Keep area closed for 2 hours (30 minutes for flying insects) before airing out. Open all doors and windows and allow to air for 30 minutes. Repeat spraying in two weeks or when necessary.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Storage: Store in a cool, dry area inaccessible to children and pets and away from heat, sparks or open flame.

Disposal: Replace cap, wrap container in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash. Do not incinerate or puncture.
