Dear Mr. Washburn:

The amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under section 3 (c)(5) of the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, is acceptable, subject to the comments listed below.

- 1. Under the "Precautionary Statements" section, move the statements "Do not use...or bottling" to the "Directions for Use" section of your label.
- 2. Either delete the phrase "or when necessary" from the statement "Repeat spraying in two weeks or when necessary" or indicate a time period for retreatment based upon the residual efficacy of your product.
- Revise "Not for Use in USDA Meat and Poultry Plants" to "Not for Use in Federally Inspected Meat and Poultry Plants."

or under counters or tables. Do not use in a room 5 ft. x 5 ft. or smaller; instead, allow fog to enter from other rooms. Turn off ALL ignition sources such as pilot lights (shut off gas valves), other open flames or running electrical appliances that cycle off and on (i.e., refrigerators, thermostats, etc.) Call your gas utility or management company if you need assistance with your pilot lights.

One 6 ounce aerosol can treats up to 6,000 cubic feet of unobstructed area (a room 30' x 25' with an 8 foot ceiling).

HOW TO USE:

Step 1: PREPARATION

Open cupboards, cabinets, trunks, and doors to area to be treated to allow maximum kill in all areas where insects can hide and breed. Close outside doors and windows and shut off fans and air conditioning to maximize killing power of fog. Remove pets, birds, and tightly cover or remove fish bowls and aquariums before spraying. Cover waxed wooden floors and waxed furniture in the immediate area surrounding the fogger (newspapers may be used). Remove or cover exposed foods, dishes, utensils or food handling equipment. All food processing surfaces should be covered during treatment or thoroughly cleaned before using. Shut off electrical appliances. Do not place activated fogger in a cabinet or under a counter or table.

Step 2: ACTIVATION OF FOGGER

section of newspaper on a level floor surface in center of room to be treated. NOTE: Do NOT place fogger on water-stainable surface. Tilt can opening away from face and depress tab firmly with thumb until it clicks in locked position. Aiming spray away from face, set fogger on newspaper, leave-room and close door. After activation, leave-room or house at once. Keep area closed for 2 hours (30 minutes for flying insects) before airing out. Open all doors and windows and allow to air for 30 minutes. Repeat spraying in two weeks or when-necessary.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Store in a cool dry area inaccessible to children and pets and away from heat, open flame or pilot light.

DISPOSAL: Do Not Puncture or Incinerate!

If empty: Place in trash or offer for recycling if available. If partly filled: Call your local solid waste agency or 1-800-CLEANUP for disposal instructions.
