STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

IF ON SKIN: Wash with plenty of soap and water. Get medical attention.

IF INHALED: Remove victim to fresh air. If not breathing give artificial respiration, preferably mouth to mouth. Get medical attention.

Avoid contact with skin, eyes and clothing. In case of contact immediately flush eyes or skin with plenty of water. Get medical attention if irritation persists. Wash thoroughly after handling and before smoking or eating. Avoid contamination of feed and foodstuffs. Remove pets and birds and cover fish aquaria before space spraying or surface applications. DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Do not use in food/feed areas of food handling establishments, restaurants or other areas where food/feed

is commercially prepared or served while food is in operation. Serving areas are served such as dining areas where foods may be prepared. Nonfood/feed areas are areas such as lavatories, floor drains (to sewer), offices, locker rooms, machine rooms, garages, mop closets and bottling).

SHAKE WELL BEFORE USE
 Remove protective cap, hold container from a distance of 12 to 15 inches.

INDOORS:
 Cockroaches, Waterbugs, Firebrats, Crickets, Scorpions, Centipedes, Sowbugs and Pillbugs. Spray in places such as cracks and crevices along baseboards and floors, hitting insects with spray when treatment as necessary.

Ants: Spray trails, nests and colonies where possible. Repeat treatment. Indianmeal Moths, Angoumois Moths and windows, direct spray into areas around stored food/feed products and darkened areas. Spray 7 to 10 cubic feet of space. Keep area closed following treatment. Ventilate area after entry. Repeat application as necessary. Exposed stages of Confused Flour Moths, Grain Beetles, Red Flour Beetles, Weevils, Grain Mites: Spray areas of processing and handling equipment, containers or other areas where insects congregate. Spray 30 seconds per surface. Keep area closed for 24 hours after treatment. Repeat application as necessary. Carpet Beetles: Spray along baseboards, shelves and caulked areas as necessary.

To Control Fleas and Brown Bats: Spray infested areas, pet bedding, cracks and crevices, along

moldings, window and door frames and localized areas of floor and floor coverings. Fresh bedding should be placed in animal quarters following treatment. Do not spray pets with this product. Treat pets with a product registered for application to pets to control the source of flea infestation. **Bedbugs:** Spray mattresses, particularly around tufts and seams. Take beds apart and spray into all joints. Treat baseboards, moldings and floors. Repeat treatment as necessary. Allow mattresses and other articles to dry thoroughly before use.

To Control Clothes Moths and Carpet Beetles on wool and other proteinaceous fibers: Remove infested articles from storage, brush thoroughly, and air for several hours in sunlight, if possible. Apply spray liberally to empty chests, closets, bureaus and other storages directing the spray into cracks, joints and crevices. After airing, infested articles may be treated by spraying lightly, keeping nozzle at least three feet from fabric to avoid staining.

OUTDOORS:

Point spray nozzle away from face. Hold can on slight downward angle. For best results, spray when air is calm. Allow a few minutes for product to take effect. Spray with wind if breeze is blowing.

PESTS OUTSIDE SURFACE OF BUILDINGS: For control of building infestation due to Ants, Clover Mites, Crickets, Earwigs, Millipedes and Sowbugs (Pillbugs). Spray foundation of building where insects are active and may find entrance, up to a height of 2 to 3 feet. Apply as a residual spray to outside surfaces of buildings where insects tend to congregate. Spray areas include (but are not limited to) screens, window frames, eaves, porches, patios, garages and refuse dumps. Repeat treatment as necessary.

CRAWLING INSECTS: Ants, Cockroaches, including Asian Cockroaches, Crickets, Centipedes, and Silverfish. Spray infested surface of patio or picnic area, hitting as many insects as possible. Also spray legs of tables and chairs to repel Ants. Spray ant hills for best control. Ants, Lone Star Ticks, Dog Ticks, Crickets, Fleas and Earwigs: Apply thoroughly to infestation in bushes, grass or weeds. For Ants, spray freely around ant trails and hills.

For the Control of Garden Insects: For use on roses, dahlias, asters and other ornamentals to kill Japanese Beetles hit by spray, as well as Whiteflies, Aphids, exposed Thrips, Spiders, Red Mites and Leafminers.

May be used on plants, as well as a multi-purpose spray in small gardens and for spot treatments of incipient insect infestations to prevent spreading in large garden areas.

May also be used on other plants such as African violets, asters, azaleas, begonias, camellias, carnations, chrysanthemums, dahlias, delphiniums, dogwood, English ivy, euonymus, fuschia, geraniums, crassula, grape vine, Kentia palm, laurel, marigolds, rhododendrons, roses, rubber plants, snapdragons, stocks, wandering Jews and zinnias.

Effective when used as directed against Whiteflies, Aphids, Spider and Red Mites, exposed Thrips, Lace Bugs, Japanese Beetles, Pavement Ants, Clover Mites and Army Worms. When spraying plants, do not operate closer than 18 inches. Use sweeping motion. Spray in one second bursts. Be cautious about wetting tender foliage, young plants and new growth. Do not spray plants when temperatures exceed 90° F. Contact insects directly whenever possible. Repeat treatment as infestations occur.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Store in a cool, dry area. Do not transport or store below 32° F. Wrap container in several layers of newspaper and dispose of in trash. Do not incinerate or puncture.
