Repeat as necessary.

Ants: Spray freely around ant trails, doors and windows and other places where ants enter premises. Spray around nests hidden under steps, brickwork, concrete, etc. Break apart accessible nests and spray freely on and around debris. Repeat as necessary.

Carpenter Ants: For effective control, locate and treat nests and surrounding areas. Apply around doors and windows and other places where ants enter premises and where they crawl and hide. Spray into infested wood through existing openings or newly drilled small holes.

Brown Dog Ticks and Fleas in Buildings: Apply in infested areas such as pet beds and resting quarters, nearby cracks and crevices, under the edges of rugs and floor coverings, between and under cushions of upholstered furniture and other areas where these pests may be present. Old bedding of pets should be removed and replaced with clean fresh bedding after treatment of pet areas. Do not use directly on pets.

Apply as a residual spray to outside surfaces of buildings where insects tend to congregate. Spray areas include (but are not limited to) screens, window frames, eaves, porches, patios, garages and refuse dumps. Repeat treatment as necessary.

Localized treatment of wood-infesting insects: Beetles and Borers (such as the following families: Anobilidae. Bostrichidae, Buprestidae, Cerambycidae, Lyctidae, Oedemeridae, Seslidae), Carpenter Bees, and Wood Wasps: Locate area of infestation and/or insect tunnels and cavities.
