#### Dear Mr. Washburn:

The amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under section 3 (c)(5) of the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, is acceptable, subject to the comments listed below.

- 1. Under the "Directions for Use" section, add the following statement: "Do not allow children and pets to enter until surfaces are dry."
- Either delete the phrases "Repeat as necessary" and "Repeat application as long as 2. insects are present" or indicate a time period for retreatment based upon the residual efficacy of your product.
- Delete the phrase "Pleasant scent." This is a subjective statement based on the sensitivity 3. of the user.



#### PHYSICAL AND CHEMICAL HAZARDS

#### ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

This product is toxic to fish. Do not apply directly to water.

#### DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Shake well before using. Hold container upright while spraying. Spray away from self and other persons.

REMOVE pets and tightly cover fish bowls and aquariums in areas being sprayed. BEFORE USING near appliances with pilot lights, be sure to extinguish pilot lights. TURN OFF electrical equipment in area being treated. DO NOT smoke while using.

TO KILL HOUSEHOLD INSECTS: HOUSEFLIES, MOSQUITOES, SMALL FLYING MOTHS, GNATS, AND OTHER FLYING INSECTS: Close doors and windows in area to be sprayed. Point nozzle upward. Direct spray to all parts of area to be treated, especially light sources such as windows. Spray for 5 - 10 seconds for each 1000 cubic feet. Keep room closed for 1 hour

after spraying. Ventilate area before reoccupying.

TO KILL WASPS, MUD DAUBERS, PAPER NEST WASPS: Spray into nests and hiding places at dusk when these insects are at rest. Repeat as necessary.

TO KILL ROACHES, WATERBUGS, SPIDERS, CRICKETS, CARPET BEETLES AND OTHER CRAWLING INSECTS. USE AS A SPOT SPRAY ONLY. Hold sprayer about 12 inches from the surface being sprayed. Spray thoroughly into hiding areas such as cracks, crevices, baseboards, damp areas and other places where insects may hide. Spray directly on insects if possible.

TO KILL ANTS: Spray around door and window frames. Thoroughly treat trails, run, walks and other places where insects may be seen.

KILLS INSECTS ON ORNAMENTAL PLANTS. TO KILL APHIDS, LEAF HOPPERS, LACE BUGS, SPIDER MITES, FALL ARMYWORMS, CUTWORMS, WHITE FLIES, CHINCH BUGS, TENT CATERPILLARS, GYPSY MOTHS, BAGWORMS AND OTHER ORNAMENTAL PLANT INSECTS: Spray ornamental plants when air is still, the dew is gone and the temperature is not above 90°F. Use with caution on young plants, new growth and tender foliage. Spray with a slow sweeping motion. Avoid wetting. Spray about 36 inches from plants. Repeat application as long as insects are present.

When used as directed, safe for use on: Houseplants such as Begonias, Ferns, Schefflera, African Violets, Geraniums, Spider plants, Wandering Jew, English Ivy, Dracaena, Swedish Ivy, Poinsettia.

Also safe for Outdoor Ornamental plants such as Roses, Privet, Zinnias, Marigolds, Honeysuckle, Verbena, Daisies, Phlox, Mock Orange, magnolia, Carnations, Evergreens, Gladiolus, Salvia, Chrysanthemums, Fuchsia, Petunias, Lilacs, Wisteria, Lilies, Veronica, Forsythia, Calendula, Birch, Ageratum.

DO NOT USE ON: Jade Plants, Cone Flowers, Aster, Ruebella or Shasta Daisies.
