DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

USE ONLY AS A SPOT SPRAY. DO NOT USE AS A SPACE SPRAY. Shake well before using. Hold can about two feet from surface to be sprayed. Spray with a slow, sweeping action to localized areas in carpeting, rugs, drapes and upholstered surfaces of furniture. Be sure to treat pet's bedding as fleas abound here

DO NOT USE in food processing plants, restaurants, or other areas where food is commercially prepared or processed. DO NOT use in serving areas while food is exposed. REMOVE pets and tightly cover or remove fish bowls and aquariums. DO NOT TREAT PETS WITH THIS PRODUCT. Treat pets with a product registered for animal application to control the source of flea and tick infestation

BEFORE USING near appliances with pilot lights. TURN OFF and extinguish pilot lights. TURN OFF gas valves in area being treated. DO NOT smoke
