- 4. Remove the statement "Repeat (treatment) as necessary" from the label following the heading "INDOORS:" and sections describing the use directions for "ANTS", "CARPET BEETLES", and "OUTDOORS", respectively.
- 5. Submit three (3) copies of your final printed labeling before releasing the product for shipment.
- 6. The basic Confidential Statement of Formula (CSF) dated December 24, 2001 is acceptable.


You should note that if you fail to satisfy any of the conditions imposed on this registration, e.g., you fail to submit the required data by the specified deadlines or the data submitted were not generated in accordance with applicable test guidelines, EPA may issue notice to cancel this use under FIFRA 6(e).

You should also note that, regardless of whether you satisfy all applicable conditions, this conditional registration will expire automatically on March 1, 2004. Sale and distribution of the subject product bearing labeling for residential sites, commercial and industrial establishments and institutions after March 1, 2004 will be illegal.

Finally, once the required data have been submitted and evaluated, EPA will entertain an application to amend the registration of the subject product to allow unconditional use in residential sites, commercial and industrial establishment and institutions.

This product is toxic to fish. Do not apply directly to water, or to areas where surface water is present or to intertidal areas below the mean high water mark.

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

GENERAL INFORMATION: Etofenprox Crawling Insect Killer I provides effective control of pests in and on buildings and structures and their immediate surroundings and on modes of transport. Permitted areas of use include areas such as: apartment buildings, homes, hospitals, and the non-food/feed areas of hotels, industrial buildings, laboratories, mausoleums, motels, nursing homes, private residences, schools, stores, utilities warehouses, and in non-food areas of restaurants, food manufacturing, processing, and servicing establishments, and on: vessels, rail cars, aircraft (cargo areas only), buses, trucks and trailers.

Note: Do not apply to classrooms when in use. Do not use in aircraft cabins. Do not apply to patient rooms in hospitals and nursing homes while occupied. For use in the non-food and non-feed areas of food and feed handling establishments. Non-food and non-feed areas of food and feed establishments are areas such as garbage rooms, lavatories, floor drains (to sewer entries and vestibules), offices, locker rooms, machine rooms, boiler rooms, garages, mop closets and storage (after canning and bottling). Remove food from food serving areas of commercial establishments prior to treatment. Wash all exposed food serving/handling surfaces thoroughly with potable water following treatment and before use. Do not use in food or feed areas of food or feed handling establishments, restaurants or other areas where food or feed is commercially prepared or

processed. Do not use in serving areas while food is exposed or the facility is in operation. Serving areas are areas where prepared foods are served, such as dining rooms but excluding areas where foods may be prepared or held. In homes, remove all food and cooking utensils. Cover all food handling surfaces and wash thoroughly after treatment and before use. Repeated exposure to etofenprox can cause skin irritation.

Do not apply this product in patient rooms or in any room occupied by the elderly or infirm. Do not apply to classrooms when in use.

Hold container upright with nozzle away from you. Press valve down and spray as directed. Spray surface until slightly wet (at a rate of 1 second to treat approximately 1 linear foot of baseboard area).

Repeat treatments to infested areas as necessary at intervals of 14 days or greater. Do not make more than 6 applications per site per year.

INDOORS:

Cockroaches, Ants, Crickets, Earwigs, Firebrats, Fleas, Silverfish, Spiders, and Sowbugs: Apply as a spot or crack and crevice treatment. Apply thoroughly to areas where these pests crawl and hide, especially in cracks and crevices, and hidden surfaces around sinks and storage areas, behind baseboards, around doors and windows, behind and under refrigerators, cabinets, sinks and stoves, the underside of shelves, drawers, bookcases and in similar areas. Repeat as necessary.

Ants: Spray around ant trails, doors and windows and other places where ants enter premises. Spray around nests hidden under steps, brickwork, concrete, etc. Break apart accessible nests and spray on and around debris. Repeat as necessary.

Fleas in Buildings: Apply to infested areas such as pet beds and resting quarters, nearby cracks and crevices, under the edges of rugs and floor coverings, between and under cushions of upholstered furniture and other areas where these pests may be present. Old bedding of pets should be removed and replaced with clean fresh bedding after treatment of pet areas. Do not apply directly on animals.

Spiders: Apply along and behind baseboards, to window and doorframes, corners, pipes, storage localities, attics, crawl spaces and other areas over which these pests may crawl.

Earwigs, Mole Crickets, Pillbugs, and Sowbugs: Apply around doors and windows and other places where these pests may enter premises. Treat baseboards, storage areas and other locations where these pests are found.

Pantry Pests - Exposed Stages of Saw-toothed Grain Beetles, Flour Beetles (Red and Confused), and Cigarette Beetles: Treat exposed stages. Remove all foodstuffs, utensils and shelf paper from area to be treated. Discard used shelf paper and any infested foodstuffs. Apply spray to shelves and in cracks and crevices behind and under cupboards and cabinets. Allow spray to dry prior to replacement of shelf paper, food and utensils.

Carpet Beetles (Black, Furniture and Varied): Spray on and under edges of floor coverings, under rugs and furniture and in closets or other localities where these insects are found. Repeat as necessary.

OUTDOORS:

Point spray nozzle away from face. Hold can on slight downward angle. For best results, spray when air is calm. Spray with wind if breeze is blowing.

PESTS ON OUTSIDE SURFACES OF BUILDINGS: For control of building infestation due to Ants, Crickets, Earwigs, and Sowbugs (Pillbugs). Spray foundation of building where insects are active and may find entrance up to a height of 2 to 3 feet. Apply as a residual spray to outside surfaces of buildings where insects tend to congregate. Spray areas include (but are not limited to) screens, window frames, eaves, porches, patios, garages and refuse dumps. Repeat treatment as necessary.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

STORAGE: Do not store near heat or open flame. Store in cool dry area away from children.

DISPOSAL: Do Not Puncture or Incinerate!

If empty: Place in trash or offer for recycling if available.

If partly filled: Call your local solid waste agency or 1-800-CLEANUP for disposal instructions.
