- d. Delete the phrase "...without persistent insecticide residues problems." from the label. Claims as to the safety of a pesticide (direct or implied) and/or false or misleading comparison with other insecticides are unacceptable.
- e. Pleas qualify the word food with the phrase food/feed, wherever it appears on the labeling, i.e. Nonfood/Nonfeed Areas, food/feed areas, etc.
- f. Under the Application for Food Areas, add the following statements:

Do not use in food/feed areas of food/feed handling establishments, restaurants or other areas where food/feed is commercially prepared or processed. Do not use in serving areas while food is exposed or facility is in operation. Serving areas are areas where prepared foods are served such as dining rooms but excluding areas where food may be prepared or held.

SEWER TREATMENTS: Cockroach infestations in sanitary sewers may be treated with approximately 4.5 ounces of [Speer Dry Insecticide][brand name] per manhole.
