"Do not use more than one fogger per room. Do not use in small, enclosed spaces such as closets, cabinets or under counters or table. Do not use in room 5 ft. x 5 ft. or small; instead, allow fog to enter from other rooms. Turn off all ignition sources such as pilot lights (shut off gas valve), other open flames or running electrical appliances that cycle off and on (i.e., refrigerators, thermostats, etc.). Call your gas utility or management company if you need assistance."

3. Submit three (3) copies of the revised final printed label for the record.

CAUTION

Harmful if absorbed through skin or inhaled. Avoid contact with skin or clothing and inhaling spray mist. Wash thoroughly after handling. Remove contaminated clothing and wash before reuse.

Do not use in commercial/food handling establishments, restaurants or other areas where food/feed is commercially prepared, processed or stored. In the home, all food processing surfaces and utensils should be covered during treatment, or thoroughly washed before use. Exposed food should be covered or removed.

PHYSICAL OR CHEMICAL HAZARDS

Contents under pressure. Keep away from heat, sparks, and open flame. Do not puncture or incinerate container. Exposure to temperatures above 130°F may cause bursting.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

This product will kill ants, cockroaches, confused flour beetles, crickets, fleas, houseflies, mosquitoes, rice weevils, saw-toothed grain beetles, small flying moths, sow bugs, spiders and ticks.

Cover exposed food, dishes and food-handling equipment. Open cabinets and doors to area to be treated. Shut off fans and air conditioners. Put out all flames and turn off pilot lights. Close doors and windows. Point valve opening away from face when releasing. Use one unit for each 6,000 cubic feet of unobstructed area. IMPORTANT! To avoid FLAMMABILITY HAZARD, use as follows: Only one can per room. Do not place in cabinet or under counter or table. Shut off electrical equipment. Place can at least 6 feet from pilot lights. Do not remain in the area during treatment and ventilate thoroughly before re-entry.

TO OPERATE VALVE: Place several layers of newspaper or pad on stand or on table in the center of the room. Point valve opening away from face. To lock valve in open position for automatic discharge, press valve button all the way down, hooking the catch. Then place fogger on stand or table with valve locked open. Leave building at once and keep building closed for two hours before airing out. Open all doors and windows and allow to air for 30 minutes. Repeat spraying in two weeks or when necessary.

To Kill Ticks and Fleas: Destroy pet's old bedding and replace with clean, fresh bedding after treatment is completed. Use product as above. Pets should be treated with a registered flea and tick control product prior to reentering treated premises.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Store in a cool, dry area away from heat or open flame.

DISPOSAL: Replace cap and discard container in trash. Do not incinerate or puncture.
