- 3. Remove the statement "Repeat (treatment) as necessary" from the label for residual treatments. The interval for residual surface treatments should be changed to 14 days.
- 4. Submit three (3) copies of your final printed labeling before releasing the product for shipment.
- 5. The basic Confidential Statement of Formula (CSF) dated December 24, 2001 is acceptable.

You should note that if you fail to satisfy any of the conditions imposed on this registration, e.g., you fail to submit the required data by the specified deadlines or the data submitted were not generated in accordance with applicable test guidelines, EPA may issue notice to cancel this use under FIFRA 6(e).

You should also note that, regardless of whether you satisfy all applicable conditions, this <u>conditional</u> registration will expire automatically on March 1, 2004. Sale and distribution of the subject product bearing labeling for residential sites, commercial and industrial establishments and institutions after March 1, 2004 will be illegal.

### FOR OUTDOOR USE ONLY SHAKE WELL BEFORE USING

Remove protective cap, hold container upright and spray from a distance of 10 to 15 feet.

#### **OUTDOORS:**

Point spray nozzle away from face. Hold can on slight downward angle. For best results, spray when air is calm. Allow a few minutes for product to take effect. Spray with wind if breeze is blowing.

Pests on Outside Surfaces of Buildings: For control of building infestation due to Ants, Clover Mites, Crickets, Earwigs, Millipedes, and Sowbugs (Pillbugs). Spray foundation of building where insects are active and may find entrance, up to a height of 2 to 3 feet. Apply as a residual spray to outside surface of buildings where insects tend to congregate. Spray areas include (but are not limited to) screens, window frames, eaves, porches, patios, garages and refuse dumps. Repeat treatment as necessary.

**FLYING INSECTS:** Flies, Mosquitoes, Gnats, Small Flying Moths, Hornets and Yellow Jackets. Allow fog to drift over area. Direct spray toward bushes, or grass from at least 4 to 6 feet away. Give special attention to breeding areas such as garbage cans and compost piles. Repeat as necessary.

**CRAWLING INSECTS:** Ants, Cockroaches, Cockroaches, Crickets, Mole Crickets, Centipedes, and Silverfish. Spray infested surface of patio or picnic area, hitting as many insects as possible. Also spray legs of tables and chairs to repel ants. Spray ant trails and hills.

Ants, Ticks, Crickets, Fleas and Earwigs: Apply thoroughly to infestations in bushes, grass or weeds.

#### STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

STORAGE: Do not store near heat or open flame. Store in a cool, dry area away from children.

**DISPOSAL**: Do Not Puncture or Incinerate!
