Dear Mr. Washburn:

I. Label Amendment:

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable subject to the comments listed below. Two (2) copies of the finished labeling must be submitted prior to releasing the product for shipment. A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records.

- 1. You must correct the third footnote (***) to the ingredient statement. Since the product contains 1.00% piperonyl butoxide (PBO) and the source product is 80% PBO and 20% related compounds, it should read as follows:
 - ***Equivalent to min. 0.8% (butylcarbityl)(6-propylpiperonyl) ether and 0.2% related compounds"
- 2. As specified in the Notice of Registration, dated January 24, 2002, you must remove the statement "Repeat treatment as necessary" from the directions for residual treatments. The interval for residual surface treatments should be changed to 14 days.
- 3. Under "Crawling Insects", "Cockroaches" is listed twice. Please delete one occurrence of this pest.

II. Revised Basic CSF:

The Confidential Statement of Formula (CSF), referred to above and submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide. Fungicide and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable. A copy of the CSF (Basic Formulation, dated June 6, 2002) has been placed in our file for the subject product. This CSF supersedes previously submitted CSFs for this product.

CAUTION

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

This product is toxic to fish. Do not apply directly to water. Do not contaminate water when disposing of equipment washwaters.

PHYSICAL OR CHEMICAL HAZARDS

Flammable. Contents under pressure. Keep away from heat, sparks, and open flame. Do not puncture or incinerate container. Exposure to temperatures above 130° F may cause bursting. Do not apply this product in conduits, motor housings, junction and switch boxes or other electrical equipment because of possible shock hazard. Do not use on surfaces that can be harmed or stained by water.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Repeated exposure to etofenprox can cause skin irritation.

FOR OUTDOOR USE ONLY SHAKE WELL BEFORE USING

Remove protective cap, hold container upright and spray from a distance of 10 to 15 feet.

OUTDOORS:

Point spray nozzle away from face. Hold can on slight downward angle. For best results, spray when air is calm. Allow a few minutes for product to take effect. Spray with wind if breeze is blowing.

Pests on Outside Surfaces of Buildings: For control of building infestation due to Ants, Clover Mites, Crickets, Earwigs, Millipedes, and Sowbugs (Pillbugs). Spray foundation of building where insects are active and may find entrance, up to a height of 2 to 3 feet. Apply as a residual spray to outside surface of buildings where insects tend to congregate. Spray areas include (but are not limited to) screens, window frames, eaves, porches, patios, garages and refuse dumps. Repeat

treatment as necessary.

FLYING INSECTS: Flies, Mosquitoes, Gnats, Small Flying Moths, Hornets and Yellow Jackets. Allow fog to drift over area. Direct spray toward bushes, or grass from at least 4 to 6 feet away. Give special attention to breeding areas such as garbage cans and compost piles. Repeat as necessary.

CRAWLING INSECTS: Ants, Cockroaches, Cockroaches, Crickets, Mole Crickets, Centipedes, and Silverfish. Spray infested surface of patio or picnic area, hitting as many insects as possible. Also spray legs of tables and chairs to repel ants. Spray ant trails and hills.

Ants, Ticks, Crickets, Fleas and Earwigs: Apply thoroughly to infestations in bushes, grass or weeds.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.
