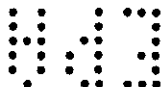

## FOR INDOOR USE

Flea Spray kills fleas and ticks. It contains a unique combination of ingredients that kills both adult and preadult fleas. Even kills fleas before they grow up to bite. NYLAR®, a unique ingredient in this flea spray, continues to kill fleas for 120 days (4 months) by preventing their development into the adult biting stage. One treatment with this spray gives continuous flea protection for 120 days. Leaves no objectionable odor or sticky mess and, used as directed, does not stain furnishings.

**FLEAS & TICKS:** Hold can 2 or 3 feet from surfaces to be treated, then invert can so the spray is pointing toward the treatment area. Treat all cracks and crevices, such as baseboards and around the bottoms of doors. Spot treat where fleas may be present such as under furniture, under edges of floor coverings, dark corners, and favorite resting spots or other places your pet frequents. Provide a good, even treatment, but do not soak the areas you treat. A fine mist or spray applied uniformly is all that is necessary to kill fleas and ticks. Old bedding of pets should be removed and replaced with clean fresh bedding after treatment of pets.

Humans and pets should avoid contact with treated areas until spray has dried. Avoid spraying furniture and carpeting. Retreat as necessary.

Fleas are best controlled by a total management program. It is suggested that infested areas be thoroughly vacuumed prior to treatment. The vacuum cleaner bag should be discarded immediately in an outdoor trash container. Continue to discard vacuum cleaner bags until the flea infestation has been brought under control. Use a registered flea control product on your pets in conjunction with this product.

**FOR OUTDOOR USE:**

Flea and ticks infesting pet areas such as, but not limited to, dog houses, dog runs, kennels, paths, patios, under eaves, shrubs or other pet resting areas. Be sure to apply uniformly using a sweeping motion to these areas to insure complete coverage.

**STORAGE AND DISPOSAL**

**STORAGE:** Store in a cool dry place inaccessible to children. Keep container closed.

**DISPOSAL:** Do not reuse empty container. Wrap container in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash.
