  - Make the following label changes:
    - a. Revise the EPA Registration Number to read, "EPA Reg. No.11715-328".
    - b. Add the statements, "Causes moderate eye irritation. Avoid contact with eyes, skin or clothing. Wash hands before eating, drinking, chewing gum, usingtobacco or using the toilet.", to the Precautionary Statements.
    - c. The term "New" may only be used for 6 months from the date of this notice.

- d. Delete all bullets referring to "revolutionary aerosol, revolution in aerosols, next generation aerosol, eliminates and eliminating. Words or phrases implying that a product posesses unique characteristics; claims which imply total eradication and misleading comparisons with other pesticides are not acceptable.
- e. There are two "If On Skin" statements. Change one to "If In Eyes". Also add "if symtoms persist" to both the skin and eye statements.
- f. A copy of the acute toxicity review is enclosed for your records.
- 3. Submit two (2) copies of the revised final printed label for the record.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA sec. 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

# PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS



#### TO KILL COCKROACHES AND ANTS:



Step 1: Insert straw firmly into the actuator.



Step 2: Spray on floors, along baseboards in the kitchen and baths. Special attention should be paid to areas around refrigerators and entry points such as doors, windows, vents, pipes, etc.

TO KILL CRICKETS, WATERBUGS, PALMETTO BUGS, SCORPIONS AND PILLBUGS: Spray on floors, along baseboards in the kitchen and baths. Special attention should be paid to areas around refrigerators and entry points such as doors, windows, vents, pipes, etc.

TO KILL FLYING INSECTS (e.g. mosquito, flies, gnats, wasps, and bees): Close space to be treated. Spray above head with a sweeping motion 3 feet from surfaces. Spray 10 grams (10 seconds)per 1,000 cubic feet of space. Keep treated area closed for at least 30 minutes after spraying. Do not remain in treated area and ventilate area before re-entry. Repeat as necessary.

TO KILL SOWBUGS, CENTIPEDES, SILVERFISH, FIREBRATS AND SPIDERS: Contact as many insects as possible with the spray. Also thoroughly spray all parts of the room suspected of harboring these pests. Special attention should be paid to cracks, crevices, hidden surfaces under sinks and behind refrigerators.

TO KILL CARPET BEETLES: Spray directly on beetles, floors, baseboards, shelves, and carpet. Allow carpet to dry thoroughly before use. Repeat treatment as necessary.

TO KILL BEDBUGS: Spray mattresses, particularly around taffs and seams. Take beds apart and spray into all joints. Treat baseboards, moldings, and floors. Allow all treated articles to dry thoroughly before use. Repeat treatment as necessary.

TO CONTROL CLOTHES MOTHS: Remove any infested articles from storage, brush thoroughly, and air for several hours in sunlight, if possible. Apply spray liberally to empty chests, closets, bureaus, and other storages, directing the spray into cracks, joints, and crevices. After airing, infested articles may be treated lightly, keeping nozzle at least three feet from fabric to avoid staining.

TO KILL EXPOSED STAGES OF CONFUSED FLOUR BEETLES, RUST RED FLOUR BEETLES, GRANARY WEEVILS, GRAIN MITES, DRUGSTORE BEETLES, MEAL WORMS, CADELLES: Spray into cracks and crevices, processing and handling equipment, around cartons or containers or other areas where these insects tend to congregate. Keep area closed for 45 minutes to 1 hour after treatment. Repeat application as necessary. Infested stored food products in the home should be disposed of.

TO KILL FLEAS AND BROWN DOG TICKS: Remove and destroy pet's old bedding. Spray sleeping quarters of pets, around baseboards, window and door frames, wall cracks and local areas of floors. Repeat as necessary.

DO NOT SPRAY ON ANIMALS. Old bedding should be removed and replaced with lean, fresh bedding after treatment. Also treat dogs and cats with a registered fleath and tick control broduct before allowing them to entertreated erea.
