

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Do not use in the food/feed areas of food/feed handling establishments, restaurants or other areas where food/feed is commercially prepared or processed. Do not use in serving areas while food is exposed or facility is in operation. Serving areas are areas where prepared foods are served such as dining rooms but excluding areas where foods may be prepared or held. DO NOT use more than one fogger per room. DO NOT use in small, enclosed spaces such as closets, cabinets or under counters or tables. Do not use in a room 5 ft. x 5 ft. or smaller, instead, allow fog to enter from other rooms. Turn off ALL ignition sources such as pilot lights (shut off gas valves), other open flames or running electrical appliances that cycle off and on (i.e., refrigerators, thermostats, etc.). Call your gas utility or management company if you need assistance with your pilot lights.

Close doors and windows. Open cabinets and doors within the treatment area. Shut off fans and air conditioners. Shut off electrical equipment. Fogger should be placed on floor in the middle of the room. Place newspapers under the container to prevent marring surfaces. Use one container for each []* cubic feet of area (approximately []*).

To start fogging, press down actuator tab to lock in position. Keep at arm's length when releasing. Point top of can away from face and eyes. Set in upright position and leave the building at once. Leave undisturbed for 2 hours. Open doors and windows and allow to air for 1 hour.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Storage: Store in a cool dry area away from heat or open flame. **Disposal:** Replace cap and discard container in trash. Do not incinerate or puncture.
