

[Prohibit applications to any types of plants on which product is known to produce phytotoxic effects.]

APPLICATION DIRECTIONS: Use this product at full strength. DO NOT DILUTE this product. SHAKE CONTAINER WELL before using this product. Apply product under conditions (low humidity, no rain, etc.) which favor rapid drying.

SPRAY APPLICATIONS: Treat all surfaces to be protected with a coarse sprayer (such as a tank sprayer). Thoroughly spray all leaves, bark, and twigs susceptible to damage from rabbits, deer, and meadow voles. For lest results in protecting new growth, it may be necessary to apply this product every 2-5 days. To protect dormant trees following leaf fall, spray twigs and trunk to the height of 5 feet. Apply product under conditions of no precipitation and low humidity to allow the repellent film to set up properly. After use, rinse sprayer thoroughly with water to prevent clogging.

BRUSH APPLICATION: Using a small clean paint brush apply a thin coating of product to leaves, bark and twigs susceptible to damage by rabbits, deer, and voles. Applications every 2-5 days may be needed to protect new growth. Rinse brush promptly and thoroughly after use.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal. Store in a cool, dry place inaccessible to children and pets. DISPOSAL: If empty: Do not reuse this container. Place in trash or offer for recycling if available. If partly filled: Call your local solid waste agency or call 1-800-CLEANUP for disposal instructions. Never place unused product down any indoor or outdoor drain.
