FOR CONTROL OF TREE SQUIRRELS, BATS, STARLINGS, PIGEONS, AND HOUSE SPARROWS

Use Restrictions: To repel tree squirrels, bats, starlings, pigeons, and house sparrows from attics and wall voids.

Application Directions: Spread flakes on floor or apply between walls, using about one pound for every 400 cubic feet. Tree squirrels, bats, and birds will depart from treated space within a short time, after which all openings through which they gain entrance, such as small crevices around eaves, bases of rafters, around dormers, should be closed by means of strips of wood, metal or by the use of oakum.
