DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

DIPEL DUST is a biological insecticide intended for use against chewing larvae (caterpillars) of certain lepidopterous species. Apply DIPEL DUST when pests are first noticed and repeat as necessary. Thorough plant coverage is necessary for control.

BROCCOLI, CABBAGE, CAULIFLOWER, COLLARDS, KALE, MUSTARD GREENS, TRUNIP GREENS: To control Cabbage Looper and Imported Cabbage Worm, apply 2 to 3 ounces per 50 foot of row.

CELERY, LETTUCE, MELONS, POTATOES, SPINACH, TOMATOES, CUCUMBERS: To control Cabbage Looper, apply 2 to 3 ounces per 50 foot of row.

TOBACCO AND TOMATOES: To control Hornworm, apply 1 to 2 ounces per 50 foot of row.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal. Store in a cool, dry place inaccessible to children and pets. **DISPOSAL:** **If empty:** Do not reuse this container.
