- d. Move the statements beginning "Do not allow children or pets..." and ending "Exposed food should be covered or removed." from the Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals to the Directions For Use.
- e. On the front panel, add "For Use Indoors at Residential Sites Only".

- f. Under Directions For Use, replace "eliminate" with "control".
6. Submit three (3) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment.



SHAKE WELL BEFORE USE

Remove pets, birds and cover fish aquariums before spraying. Do not allow children or pets to contact surface until spray has dried.

Indoors: Thoroughly vacuum all carpeting, upholstered furniture, along baseboards, under

furniture and in closets. Seal vacuum bag and dispose of in trash outdoors. Spray ETOFENPROX IGR II from 2 feet to 3 feet away from surface being treated. Apply with a smooth back-and-forth motion to carpets, drapes, rugs, drapes, and upholstered furniture. Avoid wetting or saturating of carpets or furniture. A fine mist spray that is evenly applied will do the job properly. Do not spray wood furniture, floors or trim as water spotting may occur. Repeat treatment as necessary to eliminate fleas and ticks.

Apply directly to exposed insects - roaches, ants, spiders, crickets, waterbugs, silverfish, sowbugs, and carpet beetles: Spray areas where these pests are found or may hide, including dark corners of rooms and closets, cracks and crevices, along baseboards and door sills and frames, behind sinks, stoves, refrigerators, and cabinets and around garbage cans, plumbing and other utility installations. Pests driven out of hiding places should be sprayed directly. Spray ant trails, nests and points of entry. Repeat as necessary.

On Pet Bedding: Treat pet bedding and resting places. Apply a uniform application of ETOFENPROX IGR II to nearby cracks and crevices, along and behind baseboards, window and door sills, and localized areas of floors where fleas or ticks may be present as these are primary hiding places for fleas. Pet bedding does not need to be removed after treatment.

Indoor Kennels:

Remove pets before spraying.

Spray ETOFENPROX IGR II from 2 feet to 3 feet away from surface being treated. Apply with a smooth back-and-forth motion. A fine

mist spray that is evenly applied will do the job properly. Repeat treatment as necessary to eliminate fleas and ticks.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL
