CONCENTRATED DISINFECTANT AND DEODORIZER is a concentrated disinfectant, sanitizer, and deodorizer intended for use at: Food Processing Plants, Dairies, Industrial Plants, Motels, Schools, Restaurants.

DANGER: Keep Out of Reach of Children. Corrosive. Causes eye damage and skin irritation. Do not get in eyes on skin or on clothing. Protect eyes and skin when handling. Harmful if swallowed. Avoid contamination of food.

FIRST AID: In case of contact, immediately flush eyes or skin with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes. For eyes, call a physician. Remove and wash contaminated clothing before reuse.

If swallowed, drink promptly a large quantity of milk, egg whites, gelatin solution or if these are not available, drink large quantities of water. Call a physician immediately.

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN: Probable mucosal damage may call for the use of gastric lavage. Measures against circulatory shock, respiratory depression and convulsion may be needed.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Do Not Mix With Soap Or Synthetic Detergents

Mix or hold in only plastic, glass, or stainless steel containers. Never store in aluminum, galvanized or steel containers. Clean dirt from surface before use.

RECOMMENDED USE DILUTIONS:

AFTER CLEANING FOOD UTENSILS AND EQUIPMENT: 1 oz. of Intex 846 to 4 gallons of water for sanitizing milking machines, milk cans, dishes, glasses, cutlery, and food processing equipment. For all such sanitizing, a rinse with potable water is required after the sanitizing and just prior to use.

AFTER CLEANING ROOM SURFACES: 1 oz. of Intex 846 to 1 gallon of water for disinfecting floors, institution, public rooms, homes, industrial areas, conveyors and walk ways.

MOLD OR MILDEW: For control of mold or mildew on non-porous surfaces, spray or apply until surface is moist. Repeat application every 14 days.

AFTER CLEANING INSTRUMENTS: 2 1/2 ounces of Intex 846 to 2 gallons of water for cold disinfection of surgical instruments, barber shop, and beauty parlor equipment. For instruments, it is advisable to add 1 tablespoon of sodium nitrite to each gallon of solution as an added corrosion inhibitor. Instruments should be submerged for 10 minutes.
