DIRECTIONS FOR USE

NOTE: Do not use to clean painted or metallic surfaces. Do not spill or splash outside of toilet. Will not harm porcelain or damage pipes or traps. For rapid removal of stains and incrustations, remove water from bowl and apply full strength. Use bowl swab or brush saturated with 1 to 3 ounces of PORCETEX Bowl Cleaner on all soiled areas, especially in hidden places such as under the rim or lips and in pipes leading from urinals. Wipe all surfaces, including under lip of toilet and in urinal drains. Use mirror for checking hard to see areas. Rinse surface thoroughly after treatment. PORCETEX Bowl Cleaner leaves a fresh pleasing fragrance. Contains corrosion inhibitors. Rinse out empty container before disposal.

ANTIDOTES

EXTERNAL: Wipe off acid gently, immediately flood the surface with water using soap freely, then cover with moist magnesia or baking soda. Spillage may be neutralized with baking soda.

INTERNAL: Drink a teaspoonful or more of magnesia, chalk, whiting or small piece of soap softened with water in milk, mucilage or raw egg white. In case of ingestion or injury, call a physician immediately.
