**DIRECTIONS FOR USE IN
EATING ESTABLISHMENTS**

1. Scrape and prewash utensils and glasses whenever possible.
2. Wash with a good detergent or compatible cleaner.
3. Rinse with clean water.
4. Soak in a solution of 1 ounce to 5 gallons of water (15 ppm). Immerse all utensils for at least two minutes or for contact time specified by governing sanitary code.
5. Place sanitized utensils on a rack or drainboard to air dry.

25 ppm	6	1
75 ppm	18	3
150 ppm	24	4
450 ppm	36	6

Do not use TEXODYNE in conjunction with soap or alkaline materials.

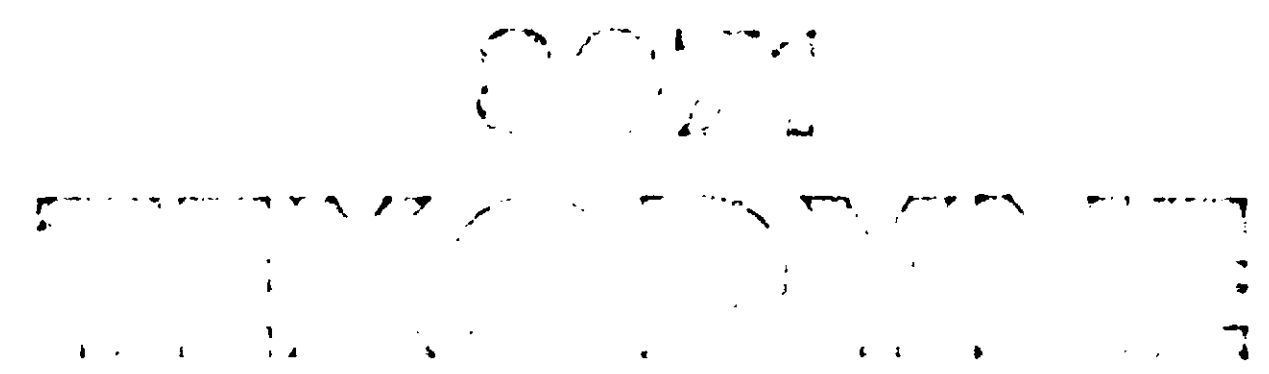

DILUTIONS FOR USE

TEXODYNE is a concentrated product and must be diluted with water before use. As a germicidal cleaner, TEXODYNE cleans and disinfects in one operation. When amber color has disappeared from the solution, a fresh TEXODYNE solution should be prepared.

ON NON POREUS SURFACES: Use a solution containing 75 ppm of iodine as TEXODYNE in water.

ON POREUS SURFACES: Use a solution containing 150 ppm of iodine as TEXODYNE in water.

TO CLEAN AND DISINFECT SURGICAL INSTRUMENTS AND THERMOMETERS: Use a solution containing 100 ppm of iodine as TEXODYNE in water.

AS A GERMICIDAL CLEANER: TEXODYNE is excellent for previously cleaned mop mops, food service ware such as utility equipment, food processing equipment, gloves, etc. Use a solution containing 75 ppm of iodine as TEXODYNE in water. To comply with Public Health Regulations, utensils, glassware and dishes should remain in the solution for 15 minutes.
