SUPER FOG INSECTICIDE SPRAY

A concentrated contact insecticide formulated for use in thermal fog generators and wet mist applicators. This product can be used in Supermarkets, Bottling Plants, Bakeries, Restaurants, Meat Plants, Flour Mills, Dairies and Industrial Plants to control insects listed below.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

FOR USE IN FOGGING EQUIPMENT TO CONTROL

Flies, Mosquitoes, Gnats, Small Flying Moths: Close room and apply mist vigorously in all parts of room, using 1 to 2 ounces for each 1,000 cubic feet of space. Leave room closed for at least 20 minutes. Ventilate room thoroughly before re-entry. Sweep up and destroy fallen insects. Repeat as needed.

Roaches, Ants, Silverfish: Use coarse wet spray and apply in all cracks and crevices in woodwork, underneath sinks, dark places behind pipes, and in all places where insects may infest, contacting as many insects as possible. Repeat as often as necessary.

Sawtooth Grain Beetles, Angoumois Grain Moth, Indian Meal Moth, Rice Weevil, Cadelles, Red Mites, Grain Mites (Accessible Stages): Spray walls, baseboards, flooring, around base of milling machinery, areas behind cabinets, around pipes and other insect harbourages using one gallon spray per 1,000 square feet of surface. Force spray into all cracks and crevices. Repeat applications as necessary.

Note: This spray applied per the directions and cautions given above, conforms with Food Additive Regulations 121-1074, 121-1075 and 121-1205 and the food additive tolerances established thereunder.

Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals
