The amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with the Label Improvement Program Notice for Antimicrobial Products Used as Food Contact Surface Sanitizers, is acceptable provided that you:

1. Make the labeling changes listed below before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling.
 - a. The misuse statement "It is a violation of Federal law . . ." should be placed directly below the heading DIRECTIONS.
 - b. In the right panel, third paragraph delete the last two sentences, which pertain to food contact surfaces.
 - c. The Storage and Disposal statement should be boxed and read as follows:

Storage and Disposal: Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal. Open dumping is prohibited. Do not reuse empty container.




