PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

DANGER: Corrosive and alkaline. Causes eye damage and skin irritation. Do not get in eyes, on skin, or on clothing. Wear goggles, coveralls, and rubber gloves and boots when handling. Harmful if swallowed. Avoid breathing dust. Use only with adequate ventilation.

FIRST AID (Practical Treatment):

If on Skin: Flush skin with cold water for at least 15 minutes. Call a physician.

If in Eyes: Flush with cold water for at least 15 minutes. Call physician.

If Swallowed: Give large amounts of water. Do not induce vomiting. Call physician.

If Inhaled: Remove to fresh air. Call a physician.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS: This product is toxic to fish. Do not discharge into lakes, streams, ponds or public waters unless in accordance with an NPDES Permit. For guidance contact the regional office of EPA.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Store in cool dry area. Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal. Open dumping is prohibited. Do not reuse empty container. Pesticide, spray mixture or rinsate that cannot be used, or chemically reprocessed should be disposed of in a landfill approved for pesticides. After rinsing, dispose of containers in an incinerator or landfill approved for pesticide containers. Consult the appropriate federal, state and local regulatory agencies for approved alternative procedures.

SPILL OR LEAK: Wear NIOSH/MSHA approved dust/chlorine respirator. Follow OSHA regulations for respirator use (sec. 29 CFR 1910.134) Wear goggles, coveralls and rubber gloves and boots. Shovel or sweep up and place in an approved DOT container and seal.

GLASS-SAN is used in the third tank of the 3-tank system of glass washing to sanitize glasses, utensils, etc. **GLASS SAN** is highly concentrated and is in an easy to use powder form.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

To sanitize glasses, dishes, mugs, knives, trays, food utensils and equipment use the following procedure:

1. Scrape and then prewash with "**GLASS-SAN**" solution (1 oz. or 2 level lbs. per quart of water) or other detergent or compatible cleaner.
2. Rinse in potable water.
3. Sanitize in "**GLASS-SAN**" solution (2 level tbs. or 1 oz. per gallon of potable water, 200 ppm available chlorine). Immerse all utensils for at least two minutes or contact time specified by governing code.
4. After sanitizing, rinse in clear running potable water. Note: Some local health authorities do not permit a final rinse but require sanitized utensils to be placed on a rack or drainboard to air dry.
5. Fresh "**GLASS-SAN**" solution should be made up each morning or just before use and as frequently during the day as is necessary to maintain 200 ppm available chlorine.
