

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

SEVERE Irritation causes skin and eye damage. May be fatal if swallowed. Do not get in eyes. Do not get on clothing. Wear goggles or face shield and rubber gloves when handling. Do not breathe dust. Avoid breathing dust. Remove and wash contaminated clothing before reuse.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

1. Adjust water pH to 7.2 to 7.6 as determined by a test kit. For pools with copper plumbing best pH factor is 7.4 to 7.8.

2. If the pool has not been previously stabilized add Davies "SUN SCREEN". Follow the directions for use on the label for that product.

3. Secure chlorinator in the area of pool that is agitated by return flow from filter. If residual remains too high, chlorinator should be moved further from the agitated area which will slow the dissolving action of the tablets.

4. In newly filled pools, follow steps 1 through 3 then add 2 tablets per 5000 gallons of pool water to establish a chlorine residual of 1.0 to 1.5 p.p.m. as determined by a test kit. Repeat dosages as needed to maintain a residual of 1.0 to 1.5 p.p.m. at all times. Thereafter, add 1 tablet per 5000 gallons per week or as needed to maintain chlorine residual of 1.0 to 1.5 p.p.m. at all times as determined by a test kit. For pools with stabilizer, follow steps 1 and 3 then add 1 tablet per 5000 gallons per week or as needed to maintain a chlorine residual of 1.0 to 1.5 ppm at all times as determined by a test kit. Please note: The pH of Davies "STABLE-KHLOR" No. 200 is on the acid side and will tend to reduce the pH and alkalinity of the pool water. Proper pH should be maintained at pH 7.2 to 7.6 as determined by a test, by periodic additions of "pH PLUS".

Each tablet weighs 162 grams or 5.7 ounces. Use also in Automatic chlorine feeders.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL: Keep product dry in tightly closed container when not in use. Store in a cool, dry, well ventilated area away from heat or open flame. In case of decomposition isolate container in open area if possible and flood with large amounts of water.

Do not reuse empty container. Rinse empty container thoroughly with water to dissolve all material before discarding. Place in trash collection or dispose in approved landfill area.
