



VULCAN # 81 ALGAECIDE

DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

Add #81 Algaecide at a point in the system where it will be uniformly mixed. Begin treatment when system is in jeopardy of becoming affected or after cleaning system.

INITIAL DOSE:

Add 3 quarts of #81 Algaecide to systems noticeably fouled or to freshly cleaned systems per 1000 gals. Repeat until control is evident.

SUBSEQUENT DOSE:

Add one quart of #81 Algaecide per 1000 gals. in system per week or as needed to maintain control. Badly fouled systems must be cleaned before treatment is begun.

NOTICE:

This product is toxic to fish and wildlife. Treated effluent should not be discharged where it will drain into lakes, streams, ponds or public water. Do not reuse empty container. Destroy by perforating or crushing and discard or bury away from water supply. Large drums should be returned to reconditioner or destroyed.
