DIRECTIONS FOR USE: Add #85 Algaecide at a point in the system where it will be uniformly mixed. Begin treatment when system is in jeopardy of becoming affected or after cleaning system.

INITIAL DOSE: When system is noticeably fouled or when system is freshly cleaned add ¾ lb. #85 Algaecide per 1000 gal. water in system. Repeat until control is evident.

SUBSEQUENT DOSE: When control is evident, add ¼ lb. #85 Algaecide per 1000 gals. per week or as needed to maintain control. Bady fouled systems must be cleaned before treatment is begun.

NOTICE: This product is toxic to fish and wildlife. Treated effluent should not be discharged where it will drain into lakes, streams, ponds or public waters. Do not reuse container. Destroy by burning with waste or by burying. Stay away from smoke and fumes.
