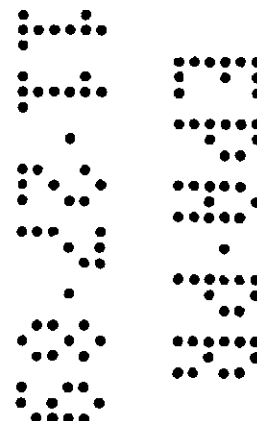

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

KILL-A-BUG KILLS EVEN RESISTANT ROACHES, ANTS -- For use indoors or outdoors. Application: Spray infested surfaces only until wet. This pesticide is highly toxic to bees exposed to direct treatment or residues on blooming crops or weeds. Do not apply this pesticide or allow it to drift to blooming crops or weeds if bees are visiting the treatment area.

Indoor Domestic Use: Do not spray in the immediate area when others are present. After application open windows and/or doors to provide adequate fresh air ventilation to the room(s). Remove clothing after spraying and launder before reuse.

Outdoor Domestic Use: Wear a long sleeve shirt and long legged pants. Spray with the wind to your back. Do not spray on windy days (wind speed is greater than 10 miles per hour). Remove clothing after spraying and launder before reuse. If clothing becomes wet from spray, stop spraying, immediately remove clothes and shower with soap and water.

Do not allow children or pets onto a treated area until the spray has dried.

ROACHES, ANTS, WATERBUGS, SILVERFISH, SPIDERS, CRICKETS, EARMIGS: Spray until wet, surfaces behind and beneath cabinets, refrigerators, sinks, stoves, ant trails and other localized areas infested with insects. For treatment around window frames and door frames, where ants enter. Repeat as necessary.

BROWN DOG TICKS: Spray infested areas around baseboards, window and door frames, wall cracks, sleeping quarters of pets and localized areas of floors and floor coverings. Repeat as necessary. Bedding should be replaced in animal quarters after treatment. Do not treat animals with this product.

ANTS, BROWN DOG TICKS AND FLEAS -- OUTDOORS: For treatment of localized infestations of insects in outdoor areas spray infested areas, including spraying of weeds and bushy non-crop areas around the home. For ants, wet hills and runways. Repeat as necessary.

STORAGE: Store in original container in a cool, dry place (preferably locked) inaccessible to children and pets. Do not store or use near heat or open flame.

DISPOSAL: Do not reuse container. Wrap container in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

Hazards to Humans & Domestic Animals

CAUTION: Harmful if swallowed, inhaled or absorbed through the skin. Avoid breathing vapors or spray mist. Avoid contact with skin, eyes or clothing. Do not allow children and pets in treated areas until surfaces are dry. Do not use in edible products areas of food processing plants, restaurants or other areas where food is commercially prepared or processed. Do not use in serving areas while food is exposed. Do not replace dishes and food until spray is dried. Do not eat food that has been sprayed. Do not smoke while using this product. For use as a spot treatment only; do not use as a space spray. Wash thoroughly after handling and before eating or smoking.

Statement of Practical Treatment

If Swallowed: Call a physician immediately. Gastric lavage is indicated if material was taken internally. DO NOT INDUCE VOMITING unless under direct medical supervision. Vomiting may cause aspiration pneumonia. If Inhaled: Remove affected person to fresh air. Apply artificial respiration if indicated. Contact a physician if warranted. If In Eyes: Immediately flush eyes with plenty of water. Contact a physician if irritation persists. If On Skin: Remove contaminated clothing and wash affected area with soap and water. Wash clothing before reuse.

Environmental Hazards

This pesticide is highly toxic to birds, fish and wildlife including waterfowl. Birds and waterfowl feeding or drinking on treated areas may be killed. Because of the migratory habits of certain Atlantic Coast waterfowl, do not apply this product in Nassau County, NY between 11/1 and 5/20. Do not exceed maximum permitted label rates. Rates above those recommended significantly increase potential hazards to birds and waterfowl. Avoid overlapping of sprays. Where irrigation (water) is recommended apply a minimum of 0.25 inch of water immediately after application. Stop irrigation before puddling occurs. Keep out of lakes, streams, ponds, tidal marshes and estuaries (except for effluence from treated watercross beds). Do not apply to water that will be used for recreational purpose and human and livestock consumption. Shrimp and crab may be killed at application rates recommended on this label.
