KILL-A-BUG KILLS EVEN RESISTANT ROACHES, ANTS: For use indoors or outdoors. Application: Spray infested surfaces only until wet.
ROACHES, ANTS, WATERBUGS, SILVERFISH, SPIDERS, CRICKETS, EARWIGS: Spray until wet, surfaces behind and beneath cabinets, refrigerators, sinks, stoves and trails and other localized areas infested with insects. For treatment around window frames and door frames, where ant enter. Repeat as necessary.

BROWN DOG TICKS AND FLEAS: Spray infested areas around baseboards, window and door frames, wall cracks, sleeping quarters of pets and localized areas of floors and floor coverings. Repeat as necessary. Bedding should be replaced in animal quarters after treatment. Do not treat animals. To treat pets use a product registered for animal application to control the source of the flea infestation.

ANTS, BROWN DOG TICKS AND FLEAS: OUTDOORS: For treatment of localized infestations of insects in outdoor areas spray infested areas, including spraying of weeds and brush non-crop areas around the home. For ants, wet hills and runways. Repeat as necessary.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL: Do not reuse empty container. Wrap and put in trash collection.
