DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

TREATS UP TO 10,000 CUBIC FEET

Leaves no unpleasant odor.

Close all doors and windows. Extinguish all open flames and remove pets or animal. Cover exposed food and cooking utensils. Turn off fans and air conditioner units. Place fogger on a table or floor in center of room and firmly depress the actuator tab. Leave area (building) at once and avoid inhaling the fumes. Treatment area may be re-entered after 45 minutes. Then, open doors and windows to ventilate the area. After airing out, flames may be relighted, fans and air conditioners may be turned back on. one hour. Open doors and windows to clear the air.

Storage: Store in a cool, dry place (preferably locked), inaccessible to children and pets and away from heat or open flame. **Disposal:** Replace cap, wrap in newspaper and discard in trash.

Hazards to Humans & Domestic Animals

CAUTION: Harmful if swallowed or absorbed through skin. Avoid breathing vapors. Avoid contact with skin. Do not use in commercial food processing or preparation areas.
