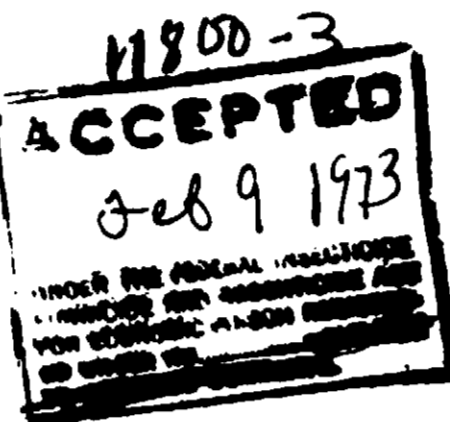

## Method of Application PLANTER BOX TREATMENT

**Corn**  
Seed Corn Beetles: Mix 4 oz. (one dispenser unit) per 50-lb. bag of dry mixture in the planter box prior to planting.

**Corn, Peas, Soybeans and Beans (Lima, Snap, White and Kidney)**  
Seed Corn Maggots: Mix 2 oz. (one dispenser unit) per 50-lb. bag of dry mixture in the planter box prior to planting.

## PLANTER BOX MIXING INSTRUCTIONS:

For best mixing results in a planter, dispense 2 oz. (one pull-out of dispenser) per 1/2 bag of seed. Stir seed slightly with a mixing stick. Add 1/2 bag of seed or treated seed, dispense 2 oz. (one pull-out of dispenser unit). Again stir seed with a mixing stick. Additional mixing is required from operation of the planter. **WITH BARE HANDS.**

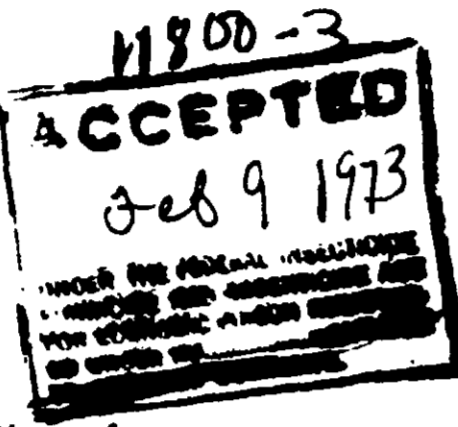

## Method of Application

### PLANTER BOX TREATMENT:

#### Corn

Seed Corn Beetles: Mix 4 oz. (two pull-outs of dispenser unit) per 50-lb. bag of seed as a dry mixture in the planter box as a seed treatment prior to planting.

#### Corn, Peas, Soybeans and Beans (Lima, Snap, White and Kidney).

Seed Corn Maggots: Mix 2 oz. (one pullout of dispenser unit) per 50-lb. bag of seed as a dry mixture in the planter box as a seed treatment prior to planting.

### PLANTER BOX MIXING INSTRUCTIONS:

For best mixing results in planter box dispense 2 oz. (one pull-out of dispenser unit) on 1/2 bag of seed. Stir seed slightly using a mixing stick. Add 1/2 bag of seed on top of already treated seed, dispense 2 oz. (one pull-out of dispenser unit). Again stir seed slightly using a mixing stick. Additional mixing will result from operation of the planter. DO NOT MIX WITH BARE HANDS.

**NOTE:** Use only on seed that has previously been treated with a fungicide.
