



### DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Hold container at a distance from the area to be treated that will permit even distribution of the dust.

Important: For an aid in reducing Face Fly populations, faces of cattle must be dusted daily. Best results are achieved when dust applicators are used as directed on an area wide basis.

### RECOMMENDED APPLICATIONS

**CATTLE, Dairy and Beef: Horn Flies & Lice - Direct Application:** Apply not more than 2 oz. /animal. Dust evenly into the hair over the head, neck, shoulders, back and tailhead. Repeat as necessary. No interval is required between treatment and use of meat or milk as food.

**SWINE: Lice - Direct Application:** Apply not more than 1 oz. /animal as a uniform coat to the shoulders and back. Repeat as necessary, but not more often than once every 10 days. No interval is required between treatment and use of meat as food.

**Bedding Treatment:** Apply 2 oz. \* uniformly over each 30 square feet of fresh, dry bedding by use of a shaker can or a suitable mechanical dust applicator. Repeat as necessary but not more often than once every 10 days.

**Direct Application and Bedding Treatment:** In severe infestations both individual animals and the bedding may be treated as directed above.

\*Note: 1 oz of this material equals approximately three level tablespoonsfuls

### USE RESTRICTIONS

For external insecticidal use only on above-specified animals. Do not contaminate food, feed, troughs, water, or water utensils. Provide thorough ventilation while dusting. Do not apply to sick, stressed or convalescent animals.

### STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT
