## PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

**PESTICIDE DISPOSAL:** Wastes resulting from the use of this product may be disposed of on site or at an approved waste disposal facility.

**CONTAINER DISPOSAL:** Completely empty the container by shaking and tapping sides and bottom to loosen clinging particles, thereby dispensing the entire contents of the can only as directed by the label. Dispose of container in a sanitary landfill or by incineration if allowed by state and local authorities. If burned, stay out of smoke.

**PAPER AND PLASTIC BAGS:** Completely empty bag into application equipment. Then dispose of empty bag in a sanitary landfill or by incineration, or, if allowed by State and local authorities, by burning. If burned, stay out of smoke.

**CONTAINER DISPOSAL:** Plastic pail with liner - Completely empty liner by shaking and tapping sides and bottom to loosen clinging particles. Empty residue in application equipment. Then dispose of liner in a sanitary landfill or by incineration if allowed by State and local authorities. Do not reuse pail, dispose of in the same manner.

#### STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL
