2. On the label for EPA Registration No. 11849-15, change "Environmental Caution" to "Environmental Hazards."

According to the specific use pattern for the product, the Environmental Hazards statement should read:

This pesticide is toxic to fish. Do not contaminate water when disposing of equipment washwaters.

3. Revise the "Note to Physician" for both products as follows:

Tetrachlorvinphos is an organophosphate insecticide. If symptoms of cholinesterase inhibition are present, atropine sulfate by injection is antidotal. 2-PAM is also antidotal and may be administered, but only in conjunction with atropine.

You may delete the manure/droppings statement on the label for EPA Registration No. 11849-15. The Agency has determined that this statement is not appropriate for end-use product labels.

Submit five (5) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment.

A stamped copy of the labeling is enclosed for your records.
