GENERAL INFORMATION

This product is a powdered insecticide for use on stored grains: Wheat, Corn, Osts, Rye, Barley, Grain Sorghum, Rice, Field and Garden Seeds. To protect stored grains from attack by Indian Meal Moth, apply this product to the surface of clean or uninfested grain at the rate of 15 lbs. per 1000 sq. feet of grain surface area. Coating will become mixed with grain as it is dumped from the truck or wagorf into the hopper. Further mixing will occur when the grain is augered or blown into the bin. Mixing is completed as the coating and grain roll down the cone shaped pile in the bin.
