Prevents the breeding of horn flies and face flies in the manure of treated cattle, when used as directed; aids in the prevention of common stomach worms (Haemonchus and Ostertagia spp.), hookworms (Bunostomum spp.) and nodular worms (Oesophagostomum spp.) of cattle. Aids in the prevention of foot rot and soft tissue lumpy jaw in cattle, when fed in accordance with directions for use as stated on back of this label.

Ingredients

Dehydrated Cane Molasses, Plant Protein Products, Processed Grain By-Products, Dicalcium Phosphate, Monocalcium Phosphate, Ground Limestone (Source of Calcium Carbonate), Salt, Cane Molasses, Vitamin A Palmitate, D-activated Animal Sterol (Source of Vitamin D3), Vitamin E Supplement, Ferrous Carbonate, Iron Oxide, Copper Oxide, Calcium Iodate, Cobalt Carbonate, Manganese Oxide, Zinc Oxide, Magnesium Oxide, and Animal Fat Preserved with BHA.

FEEDING DIRECTIONS

Self feed continuously at rate of three ounces of Master Mix Bar-Fly Mineral Medicated per day for each 800 pounds of body weight. This is equivalent to approximately 0.4 ounces per day for each 100 pounds body weight up to 800 pounds body weight. Do not exceed the feeding of 3 ounces per head daily. Be sure ample bunk space is available. Locate the mineral near the animals' water, or near their loafing area. Keep plenty of Master Mix Bar-Fly Mineral Medicated available. If bunks or feeders are empty, do not expect to maintain control of fly breeding. Observe consumption rate carefully to assure cattle are consuming at the proper rate.

Do not feed any other salt or mineral. Master Mix Bar-Fly Mineral Medicated contains all the additional salt and mineral required by the cattle, when consumed at the proper rate. The active ingredient of Master Mix Bar-Fly Mineral Medicated has been biologically tested against the horn fly, and guaranteed by the manufacturer to prevent the breeding of an average of 90 per cent or more of the horn flies in the manure of treated cattle, when used as directed.

For maximum protection against horn flies, cattle should be sprayed at the start of the fly season and fed Master Mix Bar-Fly Mineral Medicated continuously, beginning several weeks before the fly season until all adult horn flies have disappeared in the fall. Master Mix Bar-Fly Mineral Medicated prevents the breeding of horn flies and face flies in the manure of treated cattle, but does not affect any existing adult flies. Since face flies migrate from farm to farm it is essential that the larvicide program be carried out on an area basis to assist in reduction of the adult face fly population.

WARNING: Do not administer to animals showing symptoms of acute respiratory conditions. This product is not to be fed to lactating dairy animals. Occasional sensitivity to phenothiazine has been reported in cattle.
