


RATS: Apply one to four place packs (4-16 oz.) per placement area. Water taken an uninterrupted supply of fresh bait for at least 10 days.

MICE: Open packs only 1/4 to 1/2 inch. Apply one to four place packs (4-16 oz.) per placement area. Water taken an uninterrupted supply of fresh bait for at least 10 days.

SELECTION OF TREATMENT AREAS - Determine areas where rats and/or mice will most likely find and consume the bait. Generally, these areas are along walls, in gnawed openings, in or beside burrows, in corners and concealed places, between floors and walls, or in locations where rodents or their signs have been observed. Protect bait from rain or snow. Remove as much food as possible.
