

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

USE RESTRICTIONS: For control of Norway rats, Roof rats and House mice in and around homes, industrial and agricultural buildings, and similar man-made structures.

Treated baits must be placed in tamperproof bait boxes or in locations not accessible to children, pets, domestic animals or wildlife. Do not place bait in areas where there is a possibility of contaminating food or surfaces that come in direct contact with food.

SELECTION OF TREATMENT AREAS

Determine areas where rats and/or mice will most likely find and consume the bait. Generally, these areas are along walls, by gnawed openings in or beside burrows, in corners, and concealed places between floors and walls or in locations where rodents or their signs have been observed. Protect bait from rain or snow. Remove as much food as possible.

RATS: Apply one to four Packs per placement site. Maintain an uninterrupted supply of fresh bait for at least 10 days.

MICE: Open Pack. Apply 1/4 to 1/2 ounce (1 to 2 tablespoons) of bait at 8 to 12 foot intervals. Larger placements (up to 2 ounces) may be needed at points of very high mouse activity. Maintain an uninterrupted supply of fresh bait for at least 15 days.

DIRECTIONS, CON'T: Replace contaminated or spoiled bait immediately. Collect and dispose of all dead animals and unconsumed bait properly. To prevent reinfestation, eliminate food, water and harborage as much as possible. If reinfestation does occur, repeat treatment. Where a continuous source of infestation is present, establish permanent bait stations and replenish bait as needed.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Store only in original container in a dry area inaccessible to children and pets. Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal.

DISPOSAL: Do not reuse empty plastic or paper containers. Securely wrap in newspaper and discard in trash, or, if allowed by State and local authorities, by burning or burying with waste. If burned, stay out of smoke. Drum containers should be disposed in the same manner but may be reused for non-food or feed purposes if thoroughly cleaned.
