DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

PERVADE MOSQUITO LARVICIDE PETROLEUM OIL is for control of mosquito larvae around the water borders in swamps, marshes water areas, drainage areas, waste tires; settling ponds, ditches and other man-made depressions and intermittently flooded areas, such as temporary rain pools, sloughs and log ponds. Since mosquitoes can hatch in 2 to 5 days any stagnant water expected to be exposed for that period should be treated.

PERVADE MOSQUITO LARVICIDE PETROLEUM OIL should be applied at the rate of 3-5 gallons per surface acre; (for smaller areas equal to 10 to 15 ounces of product per 1,000 sq.ft.), using the higher rate where vegetation and weeds are dense. The average rate of 3 gallons per acre is equal to 36 gallon per 100 ft. swath mile.

PERVADE MOSQUITO LARVICIDE PETROLEUM OIL is noted for its water clear color and is also practically odorless. It leaves a thin film over surface of breeding areas and kills by suffocation. Mosquitoes do not develop resistance.

PERVADE: as a low odor, ready miscible oil can also be used as a mix with insecticides and as the diluent for ULV applications and Thermal Fogging.

STORAGE and DISPOSAL
