The labeling amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable provided that the following changes are made:

- 1. Update the Environmental Hazards section to read:

Do not apply directly to water except as specified on the label for this product.

Do not contaminate water when disposing of equipment washwaters.

- 2. In the ingredient statement, align the decimals as follows:

1.05%  
98.95%  
100.00%

- 3. Add the statement:


Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal.

This product is effective in controlling the growth of algae in swimming pools. The application of this product will control existing algae, and subsequent doses will control recontamination by algae. The treated water may be used immediately. NO WAITING.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Check the application chart to determine the amount of this product to use for your pool. To a freshly filled pool or at first visible signs of algae growth, pour the required amount of this product into a plastic watering can, fill with water, and sprinkle the diluted product around the edge of the pool. For best results, the mixture should be distributed equally around the edge of the pool.

WINTER DIRECTIONS

Add the necessary amount of this product to your pool prior to closing, according to the application chart. During the winter season check pool periodically for visible signs of algae and reapply this product if necessary.

FIRST AID

HOW TO ESTIMATE GALLON  
CAPACITY OF YOUR POOL

Measure Length (L), Width (W)  
and average Depth (D) in feet.  
For Square or Rectangular Pools:  
 $L \times W \times D \times 7.5 = \text{Gallons}$   
For Circular or Elliptical Pools:  
 $L \times W \times D \times 5.9 = \text{Gallons}$
